Thank you for your support and partnership in managing health-related matters the past one week. This has allowed our staff to provide continuity of learning for your child/ward. The school will continue the measures in managing H1N1 and seek your cooperation and understanding in the following:

(A) Continued Emphasis on Personal and Social Responsibility

- Any pupil who feels unwell should not come to school and should see a doctor.
- Pupils are encouraged to return home immediately after school instead of meeting together after school.
- We encourage all students to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene.

(B) Twice Daily Temperature Screening

- The twice daily temperature screening will continue until further notice.
- Visual screening for unwell students at the gate, as well as at the start of every lesson will be done.
- Temperature screening and visual screening of visitors will continue.
